ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS - 2021

The California Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (CAL-EANGUS) will award two scholarships in the amount of \$1000.00 to CAL-EANGUS members. Winners will be selected based on merit. Previous winners are not eligible. Awards are made possible through the generosity of our sponsors, USAA and private donations.

Requirements and qualifications are briefly outlined as follows:

- (1) Applicants need to demonstrate performance of their duties and be an active drilling member of the California National Guard.
- (2) Must have completed a minimum of one year of service.
- (3) Must be currently pursuing an Associate or Bachelor's degree or be enrolled in a vocational program. (Those pursuing a second bachelors degree not eligible.)
- (4) Applicants must be members of CAL-EANGUS in good standing

Applicants must submit the following:

- (1) Scholarship application (available on the caleangus.org web site)
- (2) Current transcript, statement of work progress from educational facility or other evidence of program participation.
- (3) A letter of recommendation from their unit commander, Sergeant Major or First Sergeant (company/squadron), outlining the individuals potential.

The deadline for submission of applications is **NLT 30 June 2021**.
