The California Enlisted Association is in a fantastic position to make significant improvements for the lives of Soldiers and Airmen of the California National Guard. Within the past year, CAL-EANGUS has joined the California State Commanders Veterans Council and the Veterans Affiliated Council. This has put CAL-EANGUS on the forefront of championing bills that directly impact National Guardsmen and Veterans on the State level. CAL-EANGUS is routinely consulted on how a bill will impact Guardsmen within the state.

Also, within the past year, CAL-EANGUS became the operator of the State Service Member Life Insurance program for California. This directly allowed CAL-EANGUS to financially support various programs throughout the California Military Department including donating funds to the Oakland Military Institute Track & Field Program, donating gas cards to the CMD Family Programs office, and donating to the We Care for America program.

Thanks to the passing of SB614, (which was championed by CAL-EANGUS), CAL-EANGUS is now able to partner with the California Military Department Foundation to express donated funds to Soldiers and Airmen who are in financial need. As of May, the CMD Foundation and CAL-EANGUS has provided \$13,768 in support to Soldiers and Airmen of the California National Guard.

What we really need to advance the association is membership. Membership grows the voice of CAL-EANGUS; one member at a time. To encourage membership growth, the board has voted on membership drive programs such as free membership for Junior Enlisted and deeply discounted membership plans.







Support the Creation of the Space National Guard





EANGUS has long supported legislating a separate Space National Guard independent of the Air National Guard. EANGUS believes that this is a critical action for the future of the National Guard as a warfighter for overseas operations as well as supporting homeland missions. S.4179 – A bill to establish the Space National Guard, would do just that.

The National Guard has been a part of the space missions since 1996. Nearly 3,000 Reservists, National Guardsmen, and civilians perform space operations across more than 16 space support units, in multiple states and countries. These Servicemembers are highly experienced, and many works as leaders in the space industry.

The Reserve Component has always been a complement to active duty, and they provide a unique ability to recruit industry specialists who are not interested in serving full-time. Reserve Component Servicemembers would ensure that Space Force stays at the leading edge of technology. We know how valuable the reserves components are in every other branch, therefore we believe that Space Force must create Reserve and National Guard components.

2022 Legislative Workshop Sets EANGUS' Legislative Priorities for the Year

Within the National Guard Museum headquartered in Washington, D.C., representatives from almost all of the 54 states and territories gathered to attend the annual Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United Stated (EANGUS) Legislative Workshop. This workshop was the first in-person meeting since 2020 as the 2021 was held virtually due to travel restrictions. The day was filled with guest speakers, networking, instructions and ended with a Q&A session from the top enlisted members of the Army National Guard, Air National Guard and the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Chief, National Guard Bureau.

During the workshop, it was emphasized to the audience that it is imperative that the individual state's representatives seek out, set meetings with and garner their state's elected officials support – both the Senate and Congress. With only a small full-time staff, EANGUS staff cannot visit with every elected official to encourage lawmakers to amend or change laws. Having additional states' representatives of EANGUS on the ground in the Nations Capitol greatly advanced EANGUS' progress with educating lawmakers on issues facing the National Guard.

The 2022 Legislative Priorities are: EANGUS TRICARE for all Reservists, Affordable Health Care for Gray Area Reserve Retirement, Reserve Employers Comprehensive Relief and Uniform Incentives on Taxes Act, Guard and Reserve GI Bill Parity Act.


