2025 Legislative Cycle Wrap-Up & Grassroots Urgency for Veterans

As the 2025 legislative session closes, veterans secured some important victories. The first-ever state tax exclusion for military retirement and Survivor Benefit Plan income up to \$20,000 per year will soon put money back into the pockets of 130,000 veterans and spouses. The Master Plan for Career Education will open career pathways by valuing military training for civilian credit, and Prop 1 housing funds are finally moving to veterans facing homelessness and behavioral health challenges.

These are meaningful steps forward, but not the whole story. The debate around SB 694 highlighted a difficult reality: only 134 veterans sent letters while opponents spent \$500,000 lobbying. Lawmakers told us directly, "I'm only hearing from the opposition." That message should not be repeated in the future.

Why Grassroots Advocacy Matters

Grassroots advocacy is not just about professional lobbyists in Sacramento. It's every veteran, spouse, and our allies who take a few minutes to make a phone call, send an email, meet with legislators in their districts, or share information on social media. That is what balances the conversation.

- Without input from veterans, our issues lose priority.
- With participation, even a modest number of voices can outweigh large amounts of money.
- Grassroots action helps ensure that tax relief, protections from predatory actors, and cemetery projects move forward.

If veterans stay silent, others will decide the outcome. If veterans speak up, we strengthen our place at the table.

I will continue to provide the reports, updates, and tools on social media so you can stay engaged. But it's up to you to take that next step. - **AB 53 (Ramos) / SB 1 (Seyarto):** Military retirement/SBP tax relief—\$20,000 exclusion enacted, with expansion targeted for 2026. <u>Enacted in the budget bill SB 132.</u>
- **SB 56 (Seyarto):** Removes VA disability compensation from income calculations for property tax exemption—awaiting concurrence.
- **SB 694 (Archuleta/Schiavo):** Protects veterans from unaccredited actors charging illegal fees—still alive but under challenge.
- AB 571 (Quirk-Silva): CEQA exemption to fast-track Gypsum Canyon Veterans Cemetery.
- **SB 54 (Umberg):** Court fee waivers ensuring VA disability compensation isn't counted as income—on Governor's desk.
- **AB 88 (Ta)/SB 67 (Seyarto):** Preserves Cal Grant eligibility for military dependents stationed out of state.

Important Dates

- **Sept 12** Final day for the Senate and Assembly to pass bills.
- *Oct 12* Final day for the Governor to sign or veto.
- **Jan 1, 2026** Most 2025 statutes take effect.
- **Jan 5, 2026** Legislature reconvenes for year two.

Two-year bills automatically carry over to 2026.

Near-Term Action Plan

- **District Action Teams:** By October, form local veteran teams in every Senate and Assembly district. Meet with legislators during signings, veto discussions, and hearings.
- **Sustained Engagement:** Use coordinated campaigns and social media outreach, remind supporters you don't have to be a veteran to stand with veterans.
- **Legislative Hub:** A centralized <u>Webpage</u> will track every bill, deadline, and action item so no one is left out.
- **Community Input:** Share legislative priorities through our <u>intake form</u>. We will work to carry those ideas directly to the Capitol.

Looking Ahead to 2026: Unity, Action, Persistence

The next year will bring new opportunities, but also new challenges. Opponents remain well-funded and organized. The most effective response is consistent engagement from California's veterans and supporters.

Every call, email, and meeting counts. Personal stories are often what move legislators. By working together, we can continue to secure real progress for California's veterans.



Joint Statement on Senate Bill 694

Sacramento – Senate President pro Tempore Mike McGuire (D-North Coast), Assembly Speaker Robert Rivas (D-Salinas), Senate Pro Tem Elect Monique Limón (D-Santa Barbara), Senator Bob Archuleta (D-Pico Rivera), Senator Tom Umberg (D-Santa Ana) and Assemblymember Pilar Schiavo (D-Chatsworth) released the following statement on Senate Bill 694:

"We have reached an agreement on SB 694 and the bill will immediately move to the Senate Floor in January. Veterans have earned and deserve our support. They have sacrificed so much for this country, and we're coming together to put an end to the deceptive practices that target them. This legislation deserves a vote and this bill will get its day in the legislature as soon as we return in the new year."

The legislative session reconvenes on January 5, 2026.

Mike McGuire is President pro Tempore of the California Senate. He represents the North Coast of California, which stretches from the Golden Gate Bridge to the Oregon border, including Del Norte, Trinity, Humboldt, Lake, Mendocino, Sonoma, and Marin counties.
